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**Rebuilding Together's mission is to preserve and revitalize houses and communities, assuring that low-income homeowners – including seniors, people with disabilities, and families with children--live in warmth, safety and independence. In partnership with the community, our goal is to make a sustainable impact. We are part of the largest national volunteer organization dedicated to rehabilitating homes and communities.**

**Who is eligible?** Low-income homeowners and some Community Service sites. All applicants must provide proof of ownership and financial status. Renters are ineligible.

**How to apply?** Applicants complete the application form and submit it to Rebuilding Together Santa Rosa with all required documentation. Applications for work in 2012 are due no later than October 14, 2011.

**What is the selection process?** The Board of Directors reviews applications against funding and volunteer availability. Board members and skilled trades people then visit the site and homeowner to establish eligibility criteria and work scope. Our goal is to make project selections by late Fall. All applicants will receive correspondence and/or a phone call to advise whether we are able to assist.

**What are the chances?** We receive numerous requests for assistance and services. Our ability to help is determined by the amount of funding we receive from our generous donors and the complexity of the work.

**When is the work actually done?** The last Saturday in April is our traditional workday where hundreds of volunteers come together to perform the agreed upon services. The workday in 2012 will be April 28<sup>th</sup>. However, some emergency services may be available on a limited basis throughout the year, dependent on funding and volunteer availability.

**What does it cost?** All repairs are free for homeowners. Labor and supplies are usually donated or sponsored by local corporations, individuals or service clubs.
